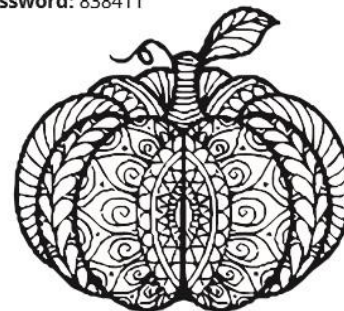
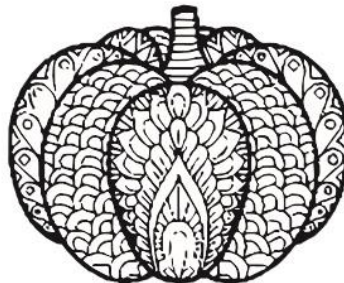
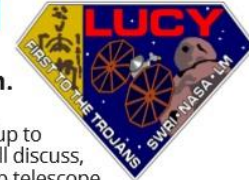


N.A.S.A. Lucy Mission & Webb Telescope

STURGEON BAY FIRE DEPARTMENT HOME FIRE SAFETY CHECKLIST

DETECTORS

- YES NO Is there one smoke detector on each level of the home and inside and outside of each sleeping area?
- YES NO Are the batteries working in all your smoke detectors? (An adult should help by pushing the test button to find out)
- YES NO Smoke detectors are less than 10 years old?
- YES NO Is there a Carbon Monoxide Detector on every level of your home? (especially near sleeping areas)
- YES NO Is your Carbon Monoxide Detector less than 7 years old?

ELECTRICAL SAFETY

- YES NO Are extension cords used safely? *Not under carpets or across doorways, not cracked or frayed, appropriate for what is plugged into it.
- YES NO Are kitchen appliances (coffee maker, microwave, toaster) plugged into separate outlet?
- YES NO Is the clothes lint filter and venting system cleaned regularly?



CANDLE SAFETY

- YES NO Candles are in sturdy fire proof containers that won't be tipped over?
- YES NO All candles are extinguished before going to bed or leaving the room?
- YES NO Children and Pets are NEVER left unattended with candles. (Matches and lighters should be out of reach of children)

COOKING SAFETY

- YES NO Does a grown up always stay in the kitchen when food is cooking on the stove?
- YES NO Are pot handles turned inward so they can't be bumped?
- YES NO Are curtains, towels and other things that burn well away from the stove?

- SÍ NO se utilizan cables de extensión con seguridad? * no debajo de alfombras o a través de puertas, no agrietado o deshilachado, apropiado para lo que está enchufado.
- SÍ NO están los aparatos de cocina (cafetera, microondas, tostadora) enchufados en un tomacorriente separado?
- SÍ NO el filtro de pelusa de ropa y el sistema de ventilación se limpian regularmente?



SEGURIDAD DE LA VELA
