

COMMITTEE CHARGE

The Sevastopol School District Board of Education authorizes the creation of an advisory committee, to be known as the Citizens Facility Advisory Committee (CFAC) and comprised of residents, which is charged with identifying and confirming needs and exploring potential solutions to our district's facility and site needs.

The Board desires the following matters to be considered by the CFAC in making recommendations to the Board of Education for potential future action:

- Identify and evaluate (in partnership with district leadership and Bray Architects) immediate, emerging, and future infrastructure, building system, educational, and outdoor space needs.
- Propose options/renovations/upgrades that support safe and accessible learning environments.
- Provide purposeful spaces that inspire innovative learning, accommodate evolving technology, and promote collaboration amongst students, staff, parents, and the community.
- Recommend a solution that is cost-effective for taxpayers and offers an enduring, energy-efficient, and adaptable end-product that will support the Sevastopol School District's future students and the residents of all the communities we serve for decades to come.
- Serve as information providers and key communicators to the community throughout the process.

CFAC members will need to commit to approximately twelve meetings from October 2017 through early June 2018.
